Student numbers almost doubled from 2003/4. As in previous years, the Further Mathematics grades gained through the MEI pilot project compared very well with the standard A-level Maths grades achieved through the students' schools and colleges.

Virtually all of these students went on to study Mathematics, Sciences or Engineering at university.

By academic year 2004/5 there were over 200 students studying in 11 different Further Mathematics Centres.
