

Using the online resources: Notes for schools and colleges registered with the Further Mathematics Network

Schools and colleges registered with the FM Network have free access to online teaching and learning resources covering further pure mathematics units and applied mathematics units from the AQA, Edexcel, OCR and OCR(MEI) AS/A level Mathematics/Further Mathematics specifications.



The free access provides one username and password, which may be used by any member of staff within the registered school/college mathematics department. The free access does not include resources to support Core 1-4, student usernames or access to the tutor administration area. If you decide you wish to obtain these, you need to subscribe to the resources through MEI; please see <http://www.resources.mei.org.uk/subscribe.shtml>.
